

After serving as a general authority for fourteen years, ten of those years under Spencer W. Kimball, Elder Lee was excommunicated on September 1st, 1989 for "apostasy and other conduct unbecoming a member of the church." Lee was the 1st general authority to be excommunicated since 1943, when Apostle Richard R. Lyman was excommunicated for living in an adulterous relationship. His autobiography proved to be popular. "Silent Courage: An Indian Story: The Autobiography of George P. Lee, a Navajo" went through nine printings. Lee had molested a 12-year-old girl under the guise of polygamy.



Poll: Americans' Belief in God Is Strong--But Declining December 17, 2013 - 10:50 AM








Character of Satan

SATAN IS




Satan's Marvelous Power
